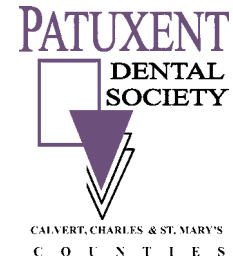

## ABOUT PRESENTATION



Dr. Henry C. Lee will cover many areas of forensic science, such as Forensic Odontology. He will also be discussing criminal Investigation, Missing Person Identification, and Historical Cases. In this course you will learn about Justice through science and lessons learned through high profile cases. He will go over new forensic technology and information on forensic DNA. Dr. Lee will go into detail regarding Forensic Odontology where you will learn the proper handling, examination and evaluation of dental evidence. ## ABOUT SPEAKER



**DR. HENRY C. LEE** is one of the world's foremost forensic scientists. He is the legendary investigator known for finding the tiniest clues. He has even solved a murder without a body. Over the past 45 years, Lee has worked with law enforcement agencies in helping to solve more than 8000 cases, including war crimes in Bosnia and Croatia, the suicide of President Clinton's former White House attorney, Vince Foster, review of the JFK assassination, and the death of JonBennet Ramsey. Dr. Lee has assisted local and state police in their investigations of other famous crimes such as the O.J Simpson trial, Elizabeth Smart and Laci Peterson.

Dr. Lee is currently the Chief Emeritus for the Connecticut Department of Public Safety, Division of Scientific Services and was the Commissioner of Public Safety for the State of Connecticut. He has taught as a professor at more than a dozen universities, law schools, and medical schools. He has authored hundreds of articles in professional journals and has co-authored more than 30 books, covering the areas, such as; DNA, Fingerprints, Trace Evidence, Crime Scene Investigation and Crime scene reconstruction. Dr. Lee has been the recipient of numerous medals and awards and is a recipient of eleven honorary Doctorate Degrees from Universities in recognition of his contributions to Law and Science. Dr. And Mrs. Margaret Lee have been married for 40 years and have two grown children, a daughter, Sherry, and a son, Stanley.

**From Baltimore:** Take Route 97 South to Route 50/301 South; take Route 301 South at the Bowie exit; follow 301 South to Waldorf. Once in Waldorf, turn left onto Route 5 South, which turns into 235 South. Stay on Route 235 (Three Notch Road) South to Lexington Park. The Conference Center and Hotel are on the right, located just past Gate 1 Patuxent River Naval Air Station; take the second right after Pegg Road (immediately following Fairfield Inn by Marriott Sign). If you miss the turn, take a right onto Valley Drive and make the first right into the Conference Center parking lot.

**From Washington:** Take Route 5 South from the Beltway to Route 301 South to Waldorf. Once in Waldorf, turn left onto Route 5 South, which turns into 235 South. Stay on Route 235 (Three Notch Road) South to Lexington Park. The Conference Center and Hotel are on the right, located just past Gate 1 Patuxent River Naval Air Station; take the second right after Pegg Road (immediately following Fairfield Inn by Marriott Sign).
